TOP PRIORITIES FOR 2016

- Supports the repeal of the water of the United States (WOTUS) Regulation.
- Supports programs and materials for use in local schools to promote agricultural literacy.
- Supports the enactment of comprehensive mandate relief that would take an inventory of existing mandates and fully fund all current and future state and federal mandates impacting local governments and schools.
- Supports the discontinuance of the Gap Elimination Adjustment (GAP) due to its adverse impact on upstate rural school districts.
- Encourage young farmers through programs such as a revolving loan fund for start-up capital, student loan forgiveness programs and tax incentives.
