GRANGE Legislative Priorities

In 2025 New York State Grange advocates for....

Agriculture

- We support family-owned dairy farms. We support dairy producers receiving a fair market price for milk which includes regional fair market pricing, farmer-led milk production growth management plans, and repeal of unfair labor mandates.
- We support the passage of an equitable Federal Farm Bill that will provide funding programs that will benefit all forms of agriculture.
- We support tax incentives for telecommunication providers to install broadband internet service in rural areas not currently served.



Federal Government

• We support continued funding of Social Security, without increasing the eligibility age, and the discontinuance of the use of funds for other purposes. We do not view Social Security and Medicare as entitlement programs. For many it is their sole source of income and/or medical insurance. It must be protected.

Education

- We support funding for agricultural education, literacy, and FFA programs that encourage awareness of and equip students for careers in the agricultural industry.
- We support the elimination of any mandates imposed by any governmental body which does not properly fund them, thus relieving the burden on local municipalities and school districts.
- We support the reintroduction of a civics curriculum in our high schools to equip our students with the necessary knowledge and skills to be effective and responsible voices in the civic dialogue necessary to maintain our Republic.

<u>Health</u>

- We support comprehensive health care reform that would address the special needs of rural areas in relation to shortages of doctors, nurses, health care facilities, and access to prescription medicines at reasonable prices to the consumer. Attention must also be given to the adequate and safe treatment of minors within the health care system. Programs such as loan forgiveness, establishment of incentives, should be developed that will encourage health care professionals to practice in the State's rural areas.
- We support all efforts to curb the use of illegal drugs and to support programs for those seeking help with their addiction.



State Government

• We support meaningful legislative reform that includes an open budget process, open legislative sessions, voter voice in pay raises for elected officials and term limits.

PRIORITIES FOR 2025

- We support the timely passage of the next 5-year cycle of a fair and equitable Federal Farm Bill.
- We support meaningful immigration reform to ease the burden on farmers who hire migrant workers
- We support adequate funding for the education of future agricultural teachers and emphasize the importance of agricultural education.
- We support all efforts to make our schools a safe learning environment for students
- We support all efforts to maintain adequate funding for Social Security recipients now and in the future.
- We support all incentives to build the necessary infrastructure needed for rural broadband services.
- We support regulations that maintain a safe working environment for all employees regardless of occupation.
- We encourage changes within the healthcare system that would cap the cost of prescription drugs to keep them affordable for all.

- We support all efforts to recruit and maintain the healthcare workers to address staffing shortages.
- We support adequate funding, training, and retention of emergency medical services personnel, especially in rural areas
